SOLUTIONS TO STORMWATER POLLUTION

A GUIDE TO HEALTHY HABITS FOR CLEAN WATER

Stormwater pollution is one of New Jersey's greatest threats to clean and plentiful water. Pollution on streets, parking lots, lawns, and in our parks is washed by rain into storm drains. Fertilizer, oil, pesticides, detergents, pet waste, and grass clippings end up in storm drains too. It then flows directly into our drinking water supplies, the ocean and our lake. We all need to do our part and prevent stormwater pollution. By sharing the responsibility and making small, easy changes in our daily lives, we can keep common pollutants out of stormwater. It all adds up to cleaner water and it saves the high cost of cleaning up once it's dirty.

As part of New Jersey's initiative to keep our water clean and plentiful, and to meet federal requirements, many municipalities and other public agencies including colleges and military bases must adopt ordinances or other rules prohibiting various activities that contribute to stormwater pollution. Breaking these rules can result in fines or other penalties.

West Long Branch residents should know that our Governing Body has already implemented many ordinances and policies in regards to the protection of our water resources. The Borough of West Long Branch and the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection recommend the following:

Keep pollution out of storm drains:

- Remember that storm drains are connected to water bodies
- Check your driveway/parking space for motor oil and other automotive fluid stains. Rain and sprinkler runoff will wash pollutants into storm drains.
- Do not let sewage or other wastewater flow into a stormwater system
- Do not drain or backwash your pool in the direction of a storm drain
- Clean your curb line. Garbage, litter, grass clippings, and leaves are washed into storm drains and prevent the proper flow of water

Limit your use of fertilizers and pesticides:

- Do a soil test to see if you need a fertilizer
- Do not apply fertilizer if heavy rain is predicted
- Look into alternatives for pesticides
- If you use fertilizers and pesticides, follow the instructions on the label on how to correctly apply it
- Maintain a small lawn and keep the rest of your property or yard in a natural state with trees and other native vegetation that require little or no fertilizer

Don't feed wildlife:

- Do not feed wildlife such as ducks and geese
- West Long Branch has a law against feeding ducks and geese

Clean up after your pet:

- Use newspaper, bags, or pooper-scoopers to pick up waste
- Never discard pet waste in a storm drain
- West Long Branch has a pooper-scooper law
Mutt Mitts are available in all Borough Parks

Dispose of yard waste properly:

- Keep leaves and grass out of storm drains
- Use grass clippings as compost. Cut it and leave it
- Use a mulching mower that recycles grass clippings into the lawn
- The Monmouth County Landfill **DOES NOT** accept grass clippings or thatch. Do not mix grass clippings or thatch in your garbage or with brush or leaves.

Grass clippings and thatch will not be collected by the Borough.

Don't litter:

- Recycle, Recycle, Recycle! West Long Branch collects recycling curbside weekly. Refer to this calendar for collection dates. Also, the Recycling Center is located at the Public Works building on Monmouth Road and is open daily.
- Participate in community cleanups
- Place litter in trash receptacles
- All Borough parks have garbage cans and recycling containers
- For disposal of any items which our Borough does not collect, contact the **Monmouth County Recycling Office at (732) 683-8686** for information

Properly use and dispose of hazardous products:

- Hazardous products including some household or commercial cleaning products, lawn and garden products, motor oil, antifreeze and paints
- Household chemicals, including paint, can be disposed by calling the **Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility at (732) 683-8686** for an appointment. This is a **FREE service** to Monmouth County Residents with proper identification.

Control car washing pollutants:

Consider using a commercial car wash that recycles its wash water. Pollutants such as soap, dirt, and oil wash into storm drains as you hose off your vehicle. If you must wash your own vehicle, use non phosphate detergent and rinse where the water will be directed to a grassy area rather than a paved area. The grassy area will absorb the run off and prevent contaminants from entering storm drains.

Each person can make a difference, but as a Community we must continue to work together to make West Long Branch a better, safer, and cleaner place to live.

THE BOROUGH **WILL NOT** COLLECT GRASS, THATCH CLIPPINGS OR BAMBOO.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL WEST LONG BRANCH RESIDENTS

Leaf collection is scheduled from October 15th to December 6th.

Do not mix brush and leaves. If leaves or brush are placed curbside outside of the scheduled collection dates, or mixed with grass clippings, they will not be collected and you will receive a Notice of Violation from the Code Enforcement Officer.

Branch and limb diameters **MAY NOT EXCEED 6"** and 4 ft in length. Tree stumps are not collected by the Borough.

Brush should not be placed more than 3 feet from the curb and shall not block sidewalks.

If residents have a Contractor or Landscaper perform services such as brush, tree, or shrub removal, it is the responsibility of the Contractor/Landscaper to remove all items from your property. The Borough will NOT collect these or any items as a result of services of a Contractor or Landscaper.

Also note that all Contractors and Landscapers **MUST** be registered with the Code Enforcement's Office prior to performing services within the Borough.

TREE REMOVAL

Permit Required, before any tree may be removed from any property in the borough, a tree permit must be obtained. This requirement applies to both live and dead, or dying trees.

Permit Fee: \$45

IF GRASS IS MIXED WITH LEAVES/BRUSH, THE LEAVES/BRUSH WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.

Household chemicals, including paint can be disposed of by calling Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility at (732) 683-8686

Plastic bags that have food waste in them **MUST be in a covered receptacle.**

Plastic bags not in a receptacle can be used for nonperishable items only.

Recycling and garbage receptacles may be NO LARGER than 32 gallons with a maximum weight of 50lbs per receptacle. **All garbage receptacles must have a secure lid.** Recycling and garbage receptacles may be placed curbside on specified dates no earlier than 4:00PM on the day before collection and removed by 8:00PM on the day of collection. **Please have all receptacles curbside no later than 6:00AM on collection day.** The Department of Public Works in conjunction with the Certified Recycling Coordinator have compiled important information in this calendar necessary for each West Long Branch residence. Please review the following list of what and how to recycle as many changes occur each year:

**NEWSPAPERS, MIXED
PAPER, CARDBOARD
& CHIPBOARD**

Clean, dry newspapers, cardboard, chipboard, glossy papers, magazines, phone books, envelopes, junk mail, gift wrapping paper, free of plastic wrappers, shall be tied with twine or rope, in bundles not to exceed fifty (50) pounds and left at the curb for collection. (See calendar for dates.) Cardboard and chipboard in large amounts must be brought to the Recycling Center.

**GLASS, ALUMINUM
AND TIN CANS**

Aluminum, tin and bi-metal cans and glass bottles and jars used for food or beverages, shall be emptied, rinsed out and placed mixed together in solid open recycling container at curbside for collection. (See calendar for dates)

**POURABLE
PLASTIC BOTTLES
With #1 & #2 LOGO**

Plastic water bottles, milk jugs, soda bottles, juice jugs, and laundry and dish detergent jugs must be rinsed; caps and closures removed and flatten when possible. Any container larger than one gallon size is unacceptable. Items are to be placed curbside for collection with glass, aluminum and tin cans.

**HOUSEHOLD
BATTERIES**

Household batteries (A, AA, AAA, 9 volt, C & D) are NO LONGER RECYCLED. These items may be disposed of with regular household trash. Button cell batteries must still be recycled due to their toxic make-up. Drop off button cell batteries into collection containers located at Borough Clerk's office or Public Works. Rechargeable batteries must also be recycled but are not accepted at the landfill. For information regarding rechargeable batteries go to www.rbrc.org
NO CAR BATTERIES ACCEPTED.

**FLUORESCENT &
CFL BULBS**

Residents can recycle fluorescent bulbs at the Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility located on Shafto Road, Tinton Falls. CFL bulbs must be returned to the place of purchase for recycling. Fluorescent and CFL bulbs are not accepted by the Borough.

ELECTRONICS:

Computer, printers, keyboards, monitors, scanners, laptops, T.V.'s (**42" & smaller & NO consoles**), radios, telephones, cameras, VCR's, DVD players, stereo components, and computer cases should be placed curbside for collection during the 4th week of the month.

BULK ITEMS

Washers, dryers, sofa beds and other miscellaneous metal should be placed curbside for collection during the 4th week of month. Furniture (without metal) that you can sit on, sleep on or eat on and carpeting that is cut, rolled, and tied into 4ft lengths may be placed curbside for your 2nd garbage collection of the week. (Thursday or Friday)

**GRASS & THATCH
CLIPPINGS**

The Borough will not collect grass or thatch clippings. Cut it and leave it. **DO NOT** mix it in garbage or with brush or leaves. **DO NOT** put grass clippings or thatch in the street, or storm drains.

PAINT

Latex

Latex paint cans must be completely dried out. Paint can be dried out by leaving the lid off until dry, adding sawdust, sand, or paint hardener (available at hardware stores). Once latex paint is completely dry, it may be placed with your garbage on your regular collection day.

Oil, Varnish, Shellacs
& Other Hazardous

MUST BE RECYCLED at the **Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility**, 3211 Shafto Road, Tinton Falls (732) 683-8686. This is a FREE service to Monmouth County Residents, but you must call for an appointment.

THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH DOES NOT COLLECT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, fluorescent bulbs, CFL bulbs, auto batteries, demolition materials, old and new lumber including 2x4's, 2x6's etc., plywood, wood fences, sheetrock, windows, doors, tile, concrete, bricks, roofing or siding materials, tires, asphalt, kitchen cabinets, countertops, oil-based paints, T.V's larger than 42" and console T.V's **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED BY THE BOROUGH.**

THINGS TO REMEMBER: No dumping or depositing of any material at the Borough Yard whether garbage or recycling shall be done after the posted hours of collection. Anyone dumping debris of any kind along streets or on property not owned by them shall be fined up to \$500.00.

Owners Duty to Maintain Property

Landscaping and lawns, hedges and bushes shall be kept trimmed and from becoming overgrown and unsightly.

It shall be the duty of the owner of any lands in the borough, where it shall be necessary and expedient for the preservation of public health safety, general welfare or to eliminate a fire hazard, to remove from such lands brush, weeds, dead and dying trees, stumps, roots obnoxious growths, filth, garbage, trash and debris.

The exterior of every structure or accessory structure, including fences, shall be maintained in good repair.

No person, owner, occupant and/or tenant of a property shall rake, blow, push and/or drag leaves, branches or trees onto a public street, except as permitted by the Department of Public Works.

It shall be the duty of the owner of any land in the Borough to keep all grass cut to a height of not more than 12 inches in length.

In a residential zone, there shall not be stored or used at a location visible from the sidewalk, street or other public areas equipment and material and/or vehicles relating to commercial or industrial uses.

No temporary signs are permitted in the Borough unless they are specifically permitted in the Borough's Zoning Ordinance. This means the contractor and tradesman signs are specifically prohibited, regardless of whether or not the property owner consents to the same.

Housing

Certificate of occupancy's shall be limited to two certificates of occupancy per calendar year for the entire premises, with no subletting, except upon a bona fide sale to a third party. **A new certificate of occupancy is required** whenever all or a majority of the tenants residing in a one-family dwelling have changed.

No person shall rent, lease or allow any person to live or occupy as a tenant or owner of any room, dwelling, or the like, **Unless a certificate of occupancy has been issued.**

The owner of every dwelling house, store or other building that may be erected shall cause the property number to be legibly placed on such structure.

The numbers must be visible from the abutting curb line and shall be at least 3 inches.

Reoccupancy (Homeowners)- No owner of rental properties, agent, real estate agent or broker, firm, company, partnership, corporation, or person shall rent, lease, let, mortgage with right of occupancy or **change the occupancy**, whether or not for a consideration and whether such change of occupancy be temporary or permanent **without obtaining a Certificate of Occupancy**. Submit reoccupancy application via borough website.

No Airbnb, No Renting of Rooms and All occupants should be listed on the certificate of occupancy.

Zoning

No front yard shall be used for open storage of boats, vehicles, or any other equipment except vehicular parking on driveways.

Zoning permits shall be secured from the Zoning Officer prior to the construction, erection or alteration of a structure.

Other than in a designated driveway, parking is prohibited in the front yard of any residential property.

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged water or other liquids or semi-liquids directly or indirectly into or upon public streets or roadway.

Borough Ordinances (Please refer to Borough Website for New & Revised Ordinances)

No. O-11-6: No parking on Borough streets when roads are snow covered.

No. 267: Garage Sale Permits. Fee \$5.00 – 2 per year per residence address.

No. 386: Any person who desires to own, operate, lease or maintain an alarm system in the Borough of West Long Branch shall file a registration application in writing with the Chief of Police of the Borough of West Long Branch on the form provided by the Police Department.

No. O-07-14: The maximum size and weight of any garbage receptacle shall be 32 gallons and 50 pounds. All receptacles shall have a lid. Plastic bags containing food waste must be in secured receptacles. Bags without food waste may be placed for collection.

No. O-07-18: Non-illuminated temporary “For Sale” and “For Rent” signs shall not be more than 4 sq. feet in area, shall be removed within 7 days after consummation of lease, or sale transaction, and shall be placed at least 6 feet from the curb or half the distance from the curb to the house, whichever is less. If there is no curb, then 6 feet from the end of the pavement.

No. O-08-10: Tree Preservation Code: Any tree removed for transplanting elsewhere must be replaced. Replacement is not required when the tree is dead or in danger of falling. A tree preservation plan must be filed together with applications before the Planning Board/Zoning Board in the case of property development. If removal of a tree is necessary to erect a structure and trees exist within the footprint of the structure, tree replacement is not required. One tree per parcel, even if healthy, may be removed every three years without the requirement for replacement.

No. O-22-13: Tree Removal. Permit Required for any removal of tree within the borough through zoning.

No. O-08-15: No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged through an illicit connection to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Borough any domestic sewage, non-contact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater).

No. O-15-3.3 (g): Each property owner, lessee and occupant of residential and other property designated by the Borough for municipal collection shall be allowed a maximum of three (3) containers of recyclables to be picked up by the Department of Public Works on any designated collection day. Each named person or entity herein shall be allowed a maximum of three (3) bulk items to be placed for collection by the Department of Public Works on any designated bulk collection day.

No. O-15-2.9 (g): No Collection of Tires. Tires may not be put out for collection and pick up by the Department of Public Works.

No. O-15-2.2: No property owner or his/her/it's agent shall place any bamboo out for municipal garbage or recycling collection.
