AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 11-4.1, 11-4.3, 11-4.4, AND 11-5.4 REGARDING PARK PERMITS AND ENFORCEMENT OF SAME IN THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH

WHEREAS, as the result of issues of violation of park permits having arisen and the Code Enforcement Officer and Borough Administrator having reported that the current ordinances permit the Recreation Commission to take certain action, when the Recreation Commission no longer has any involvement in such matters, thereby requiring an amendment to the Borough Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the issue of persons or entities charging fees for activities within the Borough parks has also arisen, which practice is not permitted, and the Borough desires to make it even more clear that such activities are not permitted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch as follows:

SECTION 1

Any reference to the Recreation Commission in Ordinance 11-4.3 is hereby deleted.

SECTION 2

Ordinance 11-4.1b is amended and supplemented as follows:

"Standards for the issuance of a permit by either the Borough Council or the Recreation Commission shall include the following finding:

[subsections 1-5 remain]

6. That the proposed activity and the persons or entities engaging in the same shall not charge a fee for the activity."

SECTION 3

Ordinance 11-4.4 shall be amended to read as follows:

"The Borough Council shall have the authority to revoke any permit upon a finding of violation of any statute, resolution, rule or ordinance, or upon good cause shown. The Recreation Commission shall have this same power for any permit issued by the Recreation Commission. Summary revocation of a permit shall be authorized by a majority vote of the Committee of the Borough Council charged with the supervision of recreation, or by a majority vote of all members of the Recreation Commission, provided a full hearing on the revocation of the permit is scheduled no later than the next regular meeting of the Borough Council on permits issued or revoked by the Borough Council. or its Recreation Committee. or within eight days of the date of the permit is summarily revoked for any permit issued and revoked by the Recreation Commission."

SECTION 4

Ordinance 11-5.4 is amended to delete the words "the designated representative of the Recreation Commission" as an enforcer of the Ordinance.

Ordinance 11-5.4 is further amended to authorize the Code Enforcement Officer and the Deputy Code Enforcement Officer to enforce these Ordinances.

SECTION 5

This Ordinance shall repeal any existing ordinances which contain language that conflicts with this Ordinance, to the extent of the inconsistency.

SECTION 6

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING PREAMBLES AND TITLES OF TWO SECTIONS IN THE ZONING CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH

WHEREAS, issues arose regarding the headings of two sections of the West Long Branch zoning code and whether the titles/preambles to both sections have been correctly stated; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has interpreted the language in Ordinances 18-4.2 and 18-4.3 to permit the stated uses and conditions set forth therein, though the titles/preambles to each section states to the contrary and, therefore, requires correction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch that the titles/preambles to Ordinances 18-4.2 and 18-4.3 be amended as follows:

18-4.2. RP Residential/Professional Zone shall not be subject to the following regulations:

18-4.3. Institutional Zone shall not be subject to the following regulations:

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE 11-4 AND REMOVING THE HEARING PROCEDURE SET FORTH THEREIN

WHEREAS, as the result of several issues that have arisen this year regarding park permits, their issuance, violations of the same, and other corrective ordinances which the Borough has either introduced or adopted; and

WHEREAS, the governing body has determined that an additional layer of bureaucracy is not needed with regard to the revocation of permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch as follows:

SECTION 1

Ordinance 11-4.4 is further amended to read as follows:

[First sentence remains unchanged]

[Second sentence was removed in Ordinance O-21-11]

"Summary revocation of a permit shall be authorized by a majority vote of the Committee of the Borough Council charged with the supervision of recreation, or by a majority vote of all members of the Recreation Commission, provided a full hearing on the revocation of the permit is scheduled no later than next regular meeting the Borough Council on permits issued or revoked by the Borough Council or its Recreation Committee, or within eight (8) days of the date the permit is summarily revoked or any permit issued and revoked by the Recreation Commission."

SECTION 2

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS 2021 GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$1,756,000 THEREFOR (INCLUDING \$280,000 IN GRANT PROCEEDS RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021) AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,405,712 BONDS OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The improvements or purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of West Long Branch, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") as general capital improvements. For the said improvements or purposes stated in Section 3, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,756,000, which is inclusive of grant proceeds to be received or received pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 in the amount of \$280,000 (the "Grant") and \$70,288 as the aggregate amount of down payment for said improvements or purposes required by the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq. (the "Local Bond Law"). Said down payment is now available therefor by virtue of a provision or provisions in a previously adopted budget or budgets of the Borough for down payment or for capital improvement purposes.

SECTION 2. For the financing of said improvement or purpose described in Section 3 hereof and to meet the part of said \$1,756,000 appropriation not provided for by application hereunder of said down payment or the Grants, negotiable bonds of the Borough are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$1,405,712 pursuant to the Local Bond Law. In anticipation of the issuance of said bonds and to temporarily finance said improvements or purposes, negotiable notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$1,405,712 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

SECTION 3. (a) The improvements hereby authorized and purposes for the financing of which said bonds or notes are to be issued, include, but are not limited to, as follows:

- (b) All such improvements or purposes set forth in Section 3(a) shall include, but are not limited to, as applicable, all engineering and design work, surveying, construction planning, preparation of plans and specifications, permits, bid documents, construction inspection and contract administration, and all work, materials, equipment, labor and appurtenances necessary therefor or incidental thereto and all in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Borough and available for public inspection and hereby approved.
- (c) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for said improvement or purpose is \$1,405,712.
- (d) The aggregate estimated cost of said improvements or purposes is \$1,756,000, the excess thereof over the said estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued therefor is the Grant in the aggregate amount of \$280,000 and the down payments available for said purposes in the aggregate amount of \$70,288.

SECTION 4. Except for the Grant, in the event the United States of America, the State of New Jersey, and/or the County of Monmouth make a contribution or grant in aid to the Borough, for the improvements and purposes authorized hereby and the same shall be received by the Borough prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes authorized in Section 2 hereof, then the amount of such bonds or notes to be issued shall be reduced by the amount so received from the United States of America, the State of New Jersey and/or the County of Monmouth. Except for the Grant, in the event, however, that any amount so contributed or granted by the United States of America, the State of New Jersey and/or the County of Monmouth, shall be received by the Borough after the issuance of the bonds or notes authorized in Section 2 hereof, then such funds shall be applied to the payment of the bonds or notes so issued and shall be used for no other purpose.

SECTION 5. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such time as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough, provided that no note shall mature later than one (1) year from its date unless such bond anticipation notes are permitted to mature at such later date in accordance with applicable law. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer of the Borough shall determine all matters in connection with the notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the signature of the Chief Financial Officer upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the Local Bond Law. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchaser thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price and accrued interest thereon from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the principal amount, the description, the interest rate, the maturity schedule of the notes so sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

SECTION 6. The capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance, and to the extent of any inconsistency herewith, a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs will be on file in the Office of the Clerk and will be available for public inspection.

SECTION 7. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

- (a) The improvements or purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses and are improvements or purposes which the Borough may lawfully undertake as general improvements or purposes, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.
- (b) The average period of usefulness of said improvements or purposes within the limitations of said Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the said bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is 9.30 years.
- (c) The supplemental debt statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Borough and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the Office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, and such statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds or notes provided for in this bond ordinance by \$1,405,712 and the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.
- (d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$351,200 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the purposes or improvements hereinbefore described.

SECTION 8. Unless paid from other sources, the full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. Unless paid from other sources, the obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Borough for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation as to rate or amount.

SECTION 9. The Borough hereby declares the intent of the Borough to issue the bonds or bond anticipation notes in the amount authorized in Section 2 of this bond ordinance and to use proceeds to pay or reimburse expenditures for the costs of the purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance. This Section 9 is a declaration of intent within the meaning and for purposes of Treasury Regulations §1.150-2 or any successor provisions of federal income tax law.

SECTION 10. The Borough Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to prepare and to update from time to time as necessary a financial disclosure document to be distributed in connection with the sale of obligations of the Borough and to execute such disclosure document on behalf of the Borough. The Borough Chief Financial Officer is further authorized to enter into the appropriate undertaking to provide secondary market disclosure on behalf of the Borough pursuant to Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Rule") for the benefit of holders and beneficial owners of obligations of the Borough and to amend such undertaking from time to time in connection with any change in law, or interpretation thereof, provided such undertaking is and continues to be, in the opinion of a nationally recognized bond counsel, consistent with the requirements of the Rule. In the event that the Borough fails to comply with its undertaking, the Borough shall not be liable for any monetary damages, and the remedy shall be limited to specific performance of the undertaking.

SECTION 11. The Borough covenants to maintain the exclusion from gross income under Section 103(a) of the Code of the interest on all bonds and notes issued under this ordinance.

SECTION 12. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final adoption, and approval by the Mayor, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
