**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-22-1  
REGARDING SALARIES OF VARIOUS MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES  
AND SETTING THE 2023 SALARIES OF VARIOUS MUNICIPAL  
OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND APPOINTEES**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council adopted Ordinance No. O-22-1 during calendar year 2022, the contents of which set forth salaries of certain municipal employees within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, upon further review, it appears that there are certain positions in those ordinances which either no longer exist, or are incorrectly stated, or there are provisions which contradict Borough policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch as follows:

SECTION 1.

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 277 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY RANGE OF VARIOUS MUNICIPAL OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND APPOINTEES", and Ordinance No. O-20-3, which is an amendment to Ordinance No. 277, be amended and supplemented to set the annual salaries for 2023, which shall be paid semi-monthly, unless otherwise stated, of the officers, employees and appointees shall be as follows:

**ORDINANCE NO. O-23-3**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF  
ORDINANCE 9-2 (CERTIFICATES OF OCCUPANCY)  
IN THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH**

WHEREAS, the Borough has been experiencing a significant increase in the number of property owners renting their properties, many for very short terms, and many for multiple rentals, without having previously sought or obtained a Certificate of Occupancy or having obtained the same; and

WHEREAS, the current penalty provisions for violating such ordinances make it more attractive to for the homeowner to violate the ordinance and collect the rent, rather than comply with the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the code enforcement officials of the Borough, together with members of the governing body, have requested that the Borough address the current penalty provisions and increase them in order to attempt to get better compliance with the Borough's ordinances, and the governing body agrees with the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch as follows:

SECTION 1: PENALTIES

Ordinance 9-2.13(b) shall be amended to read as follows:

“Any owner who violates this ordinance, or any person who interferes with the Official or any other person authorized to exercise the powers of this section, shall, upon conviction in the Municipal Court, pay a penalty of no less than \$1,000 and no more than \$1,200 for a first offense; and no less than \$1,800, and no more than \$2,000 for a second or subsequent offense; be subject to a penalty as established in Chapter 1, Section 1-5 of this code, and such action in and penalties imposed by Municipal Court may be in addition to any other action or proceeding set forth in this section.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

**ORDINANCE NO. O-23-4**

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ADDITIONAL  
CUSTODIANS OF RECORDS IN WEST LONG BRANCH  
UNDER THE OPEN PUBLIC RECORDS ACT**

WHEREAS, the Borough has experienced problems in the past, when OPRA requests were made for records not maintained by the Borough Clerk, and which were not supplied timely by the entities who were to provide those records to the Clerk, delaying the time for the Clerk to provide the records to the requestor; and

WHEREAS, the governing body believes that the preferred approach would be to have certain OPRA requests go directly to certain departments or department heads in order to save time and meet the deadlines required under OPRA (N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch as follows:

**SECTION 1. NEW CUSTODIANS OF RECORDS**

The following additional custodian of records under the Open Public Record Act, for the entities and their records, are as follows:

A. As to the West Long Branch Police Department, for police records, the Chief of Police.

B. As to the West Long Branch Fire Department, the Emergency Services Records Administrator.

**SECTION 2. WEBSITE CONFORMANCE**

The Borough website shall be modified to conform with this ordinance, and set forth the direct contact information for each of the additional custodians of records referred to above. In addition, specific OPRA request forms for those departments shall be made available on the Borough website. For informational purposes, the contact information for the current additional custodians referenced above are:

A. As to the West Long Branch Police Department, Phabermann@westlongbranch.org.

B. As to the West Long Branch Fire Department, rguidetti@westlongbranch.org.

**SECTION 3. INFORMATIONAL COPIES**

In addition to sending any request for public records to either the West Long Branch Police Department or the West Long Branch Fire Department, the requestor shall also provide an informational copy to the West Long Branch Borough Clerk, whose address will continue to be provided on the Borough's website for purposes of OPRA requests. Currently, the Borough Clerk's email address is csantos@westlongbranch.org.

**SECTION 4.**

Requestors of public records under OPRA for records of either the West Long Branch Police Department or the West Long Branch Fire Department shall be directed only to those entities, as set forth in this ordinance. The courtesy copy to the Borough Clerk is just that.



She, however, shall not be considered the custodian of public records for those departmental records.

SECTION 5. INFORMATIONAL RESPONSES

When the alternate custodian of records, as set forth in this ordinance, provides his reply to the requestor, he shall provide a courtesy copy to the Borough Clerk, so that the Borough Clerk can note for the Borough's records that the OPRA request has been responded to.
