ORDINANCE NO. 0-23-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND ENCOURAGING ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY/SERVICE EQUIPMENT (EVSE) & MAKE-READY PARKING SPACES IN THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH

WHEREAS, this Ordinance sets forth procedures for the installation of Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment (EVSE) and Make-Ready parking spaces and establishes associated regulations and other standards within the Borough of West Long Branch;

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey position is that the transition to electric vehicles contributes to all municipalities' commitment to sustainability and is in the best interest of public welfare; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has found that the installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces encourages electric vehicle adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Long Branch, at the direction of the State of New Jersey, encourages increased installation of EVSE and Make Ready parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this ordinance supports the State of New Jersey's goals to reduce air pollutants and greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector as outlined and supported by various programs related to NJ's 2019 Energy Master Plan, Global Warming Response Act (P.L.2007, c.112 (C.26:2C-37 et al.)), and EV Law (P.L. 2019, c. 362); and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2021, c.171, which Governor Murphy signed into law on July 9, 2021, requires EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces be designated as a permitted accessory use in all zoning or use districts and establishes associated installation and parking requirements; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this ordinance will support the Master Plan of the Borough of West Long Branch adopted in concurrence with P.L. 1975 c. 291, s. 1 eff. Aug. 1, 1976, and is consistent with goals and objectives of the Master Plan as well as the land use, and facilitates and supports the land use and circulation elements of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Long Branch encourages greater ownership and use of electric vehicles, thus the Borough of West Long Branch is amending its Land Use Ordinances to establish standards and regulations for the safe and efficient installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces at appropriate locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the *Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch*, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

FIRST: ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY/SERVICE EQUIPMENT

A. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to promote and encourage the use of electric vehicles by requiring the safe and efficient installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces through municipal parking regulations and other standards. EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces will support the State's transition to an electric transportation sector,

reducing automobile air pollution, greenhouse gas emissions, and storm water runoff contaminants. The goals are to:

- 1. Provide adequate and convenient EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces to serve the needs of the traveling public.
- 2. Provide opportunities for residents to have safe and efficient personal EVSE located at or near their place of residence.
- 3. Provide the opportunity for non-residential uses to supply EVSE to their customers and employees.
- 4. Create standard criteria to encourage and promote safe, efficient, and cost-effective electric vehicle charging opportunities in all zones and settings for convenience of service to those that use electric vehicles.

B. Definitions

<u>Certificate of occupancy:</u> The certificate provided for in N.J.A.C. 5:23-2, indicating that the construction authorized by the construction permit has been completed in accordance with the construction permit, the act and the regulations. See "State Uniform Construction Code Act," P.L.1975, c.217 (C.52:27D-119 et seq.) and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

<u>Charging Level</u>: The amount of voltage provided to charge an electric vehicle varies depending on the type of EVSE as follows:

- 1. Level 1 operates on a fifteen (15) to twenty (20) amp breaker on a one hundred twenty (120) volt AC circuit.
- 2. Level 2 operates on a forty (40) to one hundred (100) amp breaker on a two hundred eight (208) or two hundred forty (240) volt AC circuit.
- 3. Direct-current fast charger (DCFC) operates on a sixty (60) amp or higher breaker on a four hundred eighty (480) volt or higher three phase circuit with special grounding equipment. DCFC stations can also be referred to as rapid charging stations that are typically characterized by industrial grade electrical outlets that allow for faster recharging of electric vehicles.

<u>Electric vehicle</u>: Any vehicle that is licensed and registered for operation on public and private highways, roads, and streets; and operates either partially or exclusively using an electric motor powered by an externally charged on-board battery.

<u>Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment or (EVSE)</u>: The equipment, including the cables, cords, conductors, connectors, couplers, enclosures, attachment plugs, power outlets, power electronics, transformer, switchgear, switches and controls, network interfaces, point of sale equipment, and associated apparatus designed and used for the purpose of transferring energy from the electric supply system to a plug-in electric vehicle. "EVSE" may deliver either alternating current or, consistent with fast charging equipment

standards, direct current electricity. "EVSE" is synonymous with "electric vehicle charging station."

Make-Ready Parking Space: means the pre-wiring of electrical infrastructure at a parking space, or set of parking spaces, to facilitate easy and cost-efficient future installation of Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment or Electric Vehicle Service Equipment, including, but not limited to, Level Two EVSE and direct current fast chargers. Make Ready includes expenses related to service panels, junction boxes, conduit, wiring, and other components necessary to make a particular location able to accommodate Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment or Electric Vehicle Service Equipment on a "plug and play" basis. "Make-Ready" is synonymous with the term "charger ready," as used in P.L.2019, c.362 (C.48:25-1 et al.). Private EVSE: EVSE that has restricted access to specific users (e.g., single and two-family homes, executive parking fleet parking with no access to the general public).

<u>Publicly accessible EVSE</u>: EVSE that is publicly available (e.g., park & ride, public parking lots and garages, on-street parking, shopping center parking, non-reserved parking in multi-family parking lots, etc.).

C. Approvals and Permits

An application for development submitted solely for the installation of EVSE or Make-Ready parking spaces shall be considered a permitted accessory use and permitted accessory structure in all zoning or use districts and shall not require a variance pursuant to C.40:55D-70.

- EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces installed pursuant to Section D. below in development applications that are subject to site plan approval are considered a permitted accessory use as described in 1. above.
- 2. All EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces shall be subject to applicable local and/or Department of Community Affairs permit and inspection requirements.
- 3. The Borough Code Enforcement Officers shall enforce all signage and installation requirements described in this ordinance. Failure to meet the requirements in this ordinance shall be subject to the same enforcement and penalty provisions as other violations of the borough's land use regulations.
- 4. An application for development for the installation of EVSE or Make-Ready spaces at an existing gasoline service station, an existing retail establishment, or any other existing building shall not be subject to site plan or other land use board review, shall not require variance relief pursuant to C.40:55D-1 et seq. or any other law, rule, or regulation, and shall be approved through the issuance of a zoning permit by the administrative officer, provided the application meets the following requirements:

- a. the proposed installation does not violate bulk requirements applicable to the property or the conditions of the original final approval of the site plan or subsequent approvals for the existing gasoline service station, retail establishment, or other existing building;
- all other conditions of prior approvals for the gasoline service station, the existing retail establishment, or any other existing building continue to be met; and
- c. the proposed installation complies with the construction codes adopted in or promulgated pursuant to the "State Uniform Construction Code Act," P.L.1975, c.217 (C.52:27D-119 et seq.), any safety standards concerning the installation, and any State rule or regulation concerning electric vehicle charging stations.
- An application pursuant to Section 5. above shall be deemed complete if the application, including the permit fee and all necessary documentation, is determined to be complete.
- 6. EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces installed at a gasoline service station, an existing retail establishment, or any other existing building shall be subject to applicable local and/or Department of Community Affairs inspection requirements.
- 7. A permitting application solely for the installation of electric vehicle supply equipment permitted as an accessory use shall not be subject to review based on parking requirements.

D. Requirements for New Installation of EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces

- 1. As a condition of preliminary site plan approval, for each application involving a multiple dwelling with five or more units of dwelling space, which shall include a multiple dwelling that is held under a condominium or cooperative form of ownership, a mutual housing corporation, or a mixed-use development, the developer or owner, as applicable, shall:
 - a. prepare as Make-Ready parking spaces at least 15 percent of the required off-street parking spaces, and install EVSE in at least one-third of the 15 percent of Make-Ready parking spaces;
 - b. within three years following the date of the issuance of the certificate of occupancy, install EVSE in an additional one-third of the original 15 percent of Make-Ready parking spaces; and
 - c. within six years following the date of the issuance of the certificate of occupancy, install EVSE in the final one-third of the original 15 percent of Make-Ready parking spaces.

- d. Throughout the installation of EVSE in the Make-Ready parking spaces, at least five percent of the electric vehicle supply equipment shall be accessible for people with disabilities.
- e. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to restrict the ability to install electric vehicle supply equipment or Make-Ready parking spaces at a faster or more expansive rate than as required above.
- 2. As a condition of preliminary site plan approval, each application involving a parking lot or garage not covered in 1. above shall:
 - a. Install at least one Make-Ready parking space if there will be 50 or fewer off-street parking spaces.
 - b. Install at least two Make-Ready parking spaces if there will be 51 to 75 off-street parking spaces.
 - c. Install at least three Make-Ready parking spaces if there will be 76 to 100 off-street parking spaces.
 - d. Install at least four Make-Ready parking spaces, at least one of which shall be accessible for people with disabilities, if there will be 101 to 150 off-street parking spaces.
 - e. Install at least four percent of the total parking spaces as Make-Ready parking spaces, at least five percent of which shall be accessible for people with disabilities, if there will be more than 150 off-street parking spaces.
 - f. In lieu of installing Make-Ready parking spaces, a parking lot or garage may install EVSE to satisfy the requirements of this subsection.
 - g. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to restrict the ability to install electric vehicle supply equipment or Make-Ready parking spaces at a faster or more expansive rate than as required above.
 - h. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, a retailer that provides 25 or fewer offstreet parking spaces or the developer or owner of a single-family home shall not be required to provide or install any electric vehicle supply equipment or Make-Ready parking spaces.

E. Minimum Parking Requirements

- All parking spaces with EVSE and Make-Ready equipment shall be included in the calculation of minimum required parking spaces, pursuant to the provisions of the Borough Land Use Ordinances, including, but not limited to section 18-7.4 ("Off-street Parking, Loading and Unloading Regulations") thereof.
- 2. A parking space prepared with EVSE or Make-Ready equipment shall count as at least two parking spaces for the purpose of complying with a minimum parking

- space requirement. This shall result in a reduction of no more than 10 percent of the total required parking.
- 3. All parking space calculations for EVSE and Make-Ready equipment shall be rounded up to the next full parking space.
- Additional installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces above what is required in Section D. above may be encouraged but shall not be required in development projects.

F. Reasonable Standards for All New EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces

- 1. Location and layout of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces is expected to vary based on the design and use of the primary parking area. It is expected flexibility will be required to provide the most convenient and functional service to users. Standards and criteria should be considered guidelines and flexibility should be allowed when alternatives can better achieve objectives for provision of this service.
 - 2. Installation:
- a. Installation of EVSE and Make-Ready parking spaces shall meet the electrical subcode of the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.16.
- b. Each EVSE or Make-Ready parking space that is not accessible for people with disabilities shall be not less than 9 feet wide or 18 feet in length. Exceptions may be made for existing parking spaces or parking spaces that were part of an application that received prior site plan approval.
- c. To the extent practical, the location of accessible parking spaces for people with disabilities with EVSE and Make Ready equipment shall comply with the general accessibility requirements of the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23, and other applicable accessibility standards.
- d. Each EVSE or Make-Ready parking space that is accessible for people with disabilities shall comply with the sizing of accessible parking space requirements in the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23, and other applicable accessibility standards.

3. EVSE Parking:

- a. Publicly-accessible EVSE shall be reserved for parking and charging electric vehicles only. Electric vehicles shall be connected to the EVSE. The use of time limits is optional and shall be determined by the owner.
- b. Electric vehicles may be parked in any parking space designated for parking, subject to the restrictions that would apply to any other vehicle that would park in that space.
- c. Public Parking. Pursuant to NJSA 40:48-2, publicly-accessible EVSE parking spaces shall be monitored by the municipality's police department and enforced in the same manner as any other parking. It shall be a violation of this Section to park

or stand a non-electric vehicle in such a space, or to park an electric vehicle in such a space when it is not connected to the EVSE. Any non-electric vehicle parked or standing in a EVSE parking space or any electric vehicle parked and not connected to the EVSE shall be subject to fine and/or impoundment of the offending vehicle as described in the general penalty provisions of this West Long Branch Municipal Ordinances which prohibit parking in designated no parking areas or zones other than handicapped parking restrictions. Signage indicating the penalties for violations shall comply with Section 5. below. Any vehicle parked in such a space shall make the appropriate payment for the space and observe the time limit for the underlying parking area, if applicable.

d. Private Parking. The use of EVSE shall be monitored by the property owner or designee.

4. Safety

- a. Each publicly accessible EVSE shall be located at a parking space that is designated for electric vehicles only and identified by green painted pavement and/or curb markings, a green painted charging pictograph symbol, and appropriate signage pursuant to Section 5. below.
- b. Where EVSE is installed, adequate site lighting and landscaping shall be provided in accordance with the borough's ordinances and regulations.
- c. Adequate EVSE protection such as concrete-filled steel bollards shall be used for publicly accessible EVSE. Non-mountable curbing may be used in lieu of bollards if the EVSE is setback a minimum of 24 inches from the face of the curb. Any standalone EVSE bollards should be 3 to 4-feet high with concrete footings placed to protect the EVSE from accidental impact and to prevent damage from equipment used for snow removal.
- d. EVSE outlets and connector devices shall be no less than 36 inches and no higher than 48 inches from the ground or pavement surface where mounted, and shall contain a cord management system as described in e. below. Equipment mounted on pedestals, lighting posts, bollards, or other devices shall be designated and located as to not impede pedestrian travel, create trip hazards on sidewalks, or impede snow removal.
 - e. Each EVSE shall incorporate a cord management system or method to minimize the potential for cable entanglement, user injury, or connector damage. Cords shall be retractable or have a place to hang the connector and cord a safe and sufficient distance above the ground or pavement surface. Any cords connecting the charger to a vehicle shall be configured so that they do not cross a driveway, sidewalk, or passenger unloading area.

- f. Where EVSE is provided within a pedestrian circulation area, such as a sidewalk or other accessible route to a building entrance, the EVSE shall be located so as not to interfere with accessibility requirements of the Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23, and other applicable accessibility standards.
- g. Publicly accessible EVSEs shall be maintained in all respects, including the functioning of the equipment. A 24-hour on-call contact shall be provided on the equipment for reporting problems with the equipment or access to it. To allow for maintenance and notification, the borough shall require the owners/designee of publicly accessible EVSE to provide information on the EVSE's geographic location, date of installation, equipment type and model, and owner contact information.

5. Signs

- a. Publicly accessible EVSE shall have posted regulatory signs, as identified in this section, allowing only charging electric vehicles to park in such spaces. For purposes of this section, "charging" means that an electric vehicle is parked at an EVSE and is connected to the EVSE. If time limits or vehicle removal provisions are to be enforced, regulatory signs including parking restrictions shall be installed immediately adjacent to, and visible from the EVSE. For private EVSE, installation of signs and sign text is at the discretion of the owner.
- b. All regulatory signs shall comply with visibility, legibility, size, shape, color, and reflectivity requirements contained within the Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as published by the Federal Highway Administration.
- c. Wayfinding or directional signs, if necessary, shall be permitted at appropriate decision points to effectively guide motorists to the EVSE parking space(s). Wayfinding or directional signage shall be placed in a manner that shall not interfere with any parking space, drive lane, or exit and shall comply with b. above.
- d. In addition to the signage described above, the following information shall be available on the EVSE or posted at or adjacent to all publicly-accessible EVSE parking spaces:
 - Hour of operations and/or time limits if time limits or tow-away provisions are to be enforced by the municipality or owner/designee;
 - 2) Usage fees and parking fees, if applicable; and
 - 3) Contact information (telephone number) for reporting when the equipment is not operating or other problems.

6. Usage Fees

Private EVSE: Nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to preclude a private owner/designee of an EVSE from collecting a fee for the use of the EVSE, in accordance

with applicable State and Federal regulations. Fees shall be available on the EVSE or posted at or adjacent to the EVSE parking space.

SECOND: SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

necessary on the terms stated bellow. Services are defined as the rescue, custody and care

of injured animals, trapped animals, sick animals, animals whose lives are endangered or animals present a danger to humans, including those who have bitten a person.

For the purpose of this Agreement, marine mammals, feral cat colonies and dead deer are specifically excluded, neither shall the MCSPCA trap, rescue, or relocate or care for geese unless same is in need of veterinary care.

Upon the Municipality's request, or in the case for the need of animal humane and/or Services as defines herein, feral cat colonies will remain the responsibility of the person "caretaker" caring for the cats. If there is a sick, rabid, or injured cat, the MCSPCA will provide services and assistance, and shall be entitled to be reimbursed for all the costs and expenses to said feral cat colony. If the colony is abandoned by the caretaker and the MCSPCA is called to remove any and/or care for the colony, the costs and expenses incurred by the MCSPCA will be in addition to the cost for Services and will be the responsibility of the Municipality. If the Municipality enters into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the MCSPCA for the purpose of TNR, then all terms of the MOU shall be set forth as agreed upon by the MCSPCA and the Municipality and shall supersede certain terms in this contract.

- 2. The Municipality will pay the MCSPCA the sum of \$6,250.00 [5 months] (\$15,000.00 Annually) said sum to be prorated on a monthly basis of \$1,250,00. Payment for all services, including additional costs and expenses as stated herein, and unless express terms to the contrary are agreed, are due thirty (30) days after presentment of invoice and/or Municipality voucher executed by appropriate party, time is of the essence.
- 3. It is expressly understood, except as otherwise stated, the services include all the costs and expenses incurred by the MCSPCA or its animal control officer in the maintenance of custodial facilities and vehicle to be used by the animal control officer.

- 4. Upon a request from the Municipality, the MCSPCA shall respond to an emergency as defined herein. Emergency veterinary treatment will be provided to an ill or injured animal as required by the State Law regulation. The MCSPCA reserves the right in its sole discretion to determine that if the animal requires transportation to an emergency clinic on nights, weekends, or holidays, when our own veterinarians are not available.
 - If there is no known owner, the cost of in house services shall be covered by the MCSPCA, any expense incurred by the MCSPCA for outside veterinary services will be the responsibility of the Municipality. If the owner is known, the cost and expenses will be bore by the owner.
- 5. The MCSPCA shall, at the request of an owner of an unwanted animal, render assistance in delivery of said animal to an appropriate humane shelter, including a shelter maintained by the MCSPCA. The MCSPCA will be paid for the cost and expenses of such assistance, which shall be the responsibility of the owner.
- 6. The MCSPCA shall use reasonable efforts to impound any stray, abandoned or unlicensed dog or cat, running at large on public property within the municipality. When such impoundment occurs, the dog or cat shall be put up for adoption or humanly disposed of, at the sole and exclusive discretion of the MCSPCA, after seven (7) day statutory hold period. It is expressly understood, once the MCSPCA accepts any animal and takes it into custody; it shall become the property of the MCSPCA for the disposition a stated above. The MCSPCA Animal Control Officer (ACO) or MCSPCA Humane Law Enforcement Officer shall issue summons for Municipal Ordinances and NJ Title 4 pertaining to all animal laws that apply under the scope of the ACO's employment. (ie: Dog/Cat licensing, animals running at large, dangerous dog)

- 7. Upon proof of ownership, any person may redeem his/her animal from the MCSPCA upon payment to the MCSPCA and shall be responsible to pay for any vaccinations and/or necessary medical treatment that the medical team deemed necessary.

 Once the ownership is established, and the animal is no longer a stray, regular boarding rates at \$20.00 per day shall be paid to the MCSPCA by the owner prior to the release of the animal. No release or redemption shall be honored unless the owner provides proof of ownership and produces a current municipal dog/cat license if applicable. If an animal is unclaimed after seven (7) days, the MCSPCA shall by law take ownership of the animal and offer the animal for adoption, humanly disposed of or any other disposition that the MCSPCA deems humanely appropriate.
- 8. Any stray dog, cat or any other animal taken into the custody of the MCSPCA and charged with biting a human being, shall be quarantined for the required period of ten (10) days. The cost and expenses incurred during this period shall be the responsibility of the owner. If no known owner, the costs shall be absorbed by the MCSPCA.
- 9. Transportation of the head of the animal suspected of rabies to the State department shall be provided by the MCSPCA under the condition that the said animal expired on the premises before the ten (10) day quarantine period referred to above. The fee for removal of the head and deliver for rabies examination will be paid by the owner of the animal or absorbed by the MCSPCA if the owner is unknown.
- 10. The animal control officer shall be an employee of the MCSPCA. The MCSPCA shall indemnify and hold the Municipality harmless from and against any damage caused by the animal control officer, expressly excluded damage caused by the animal.
- 11. Removal of an animal, including wildlife, inside a home, apartment building, garage, roof, etc., "residence", is not covered under this agreement. The MCSPCA reserves the right to

- answer/respond to those calls, however, the owner of the premises will be charged \$90.00 per hour during standard business hours and \$118.00 after standard hours. If the nature of the call is deemed by a police officer and/or Code Enforcement Officer to pose a public safety risk, the MCSPCA shall respond at no cost to the owner of the premise.
- 12. The MCSPCA shall not be responsible for handling deer or any wildlife carcasses. However the MCSPCA shall retrieve infirmed/injured deer or wildlife at the MCSPCA's discretion.
- 13. The Municipality will be charged at an additional charge, a boarding fee of \$20.00 per day, payable monthly, for any animal which, upon request of the Municipality as part of a court process or upon order from a court shall impound an animal. The Municipality agrees to expressively seek reimbursement from the costs uncured by the MCSPCA as any judgment from the owner, in the absence as such; the costs shall be the responsibility of the Municipality.
- 14. The signatory of this document represents that it/he/she possess the requisite authority to bind the public entity further represents the execution of the Agreement is authorized by Municipality.
- 15. Except for non-payment, this Agreement contract may be terminated during the Term by either party upon sixty (60) days written notice by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, to the other party, in its sole discretion the terminating party may provide an opportunity to cure.
- 16. It is expressively agreed that the MCSPCA is not obligated to incur any cost, expense or legal fees as a consequence of the failure of the Municipality to timely and fully remit all payment due hereunder; such costs, expenses, legal fees shall be the sole responsibility of the Municipality.
- 17. The Parties hereto shall indemnify and hold the other harmless from and against any claim, award, cost, expense by any third party, not affiliated in any way employed by either party for any damage or injury caused by the act or omission of the indemnifying party or its agents.

THIS AGREEMENT is a sole expression of the understanding between the parties and may only be modified by a written amendment signed by both parties.

COMMODITY RESALE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH (the "COUNTY") AND

BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH (the "LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY")

The County and the Local Government Entity enter into this agreement pursuant to the Rules governing cooperative purchasing, namely *N.J.A.C.* 5:34-7.15 *et seq*.

IT IS AGREED:

- 1. **Commodities Offered.** The County will offer the commodities listed on Exhibit A to the Local Government Entity through the Monmouth County Commodity Resale System (SYSTEM IDENTIFIER 99174 MCCRS).
- 2. **Amendment to Services Offered.** The County, in its discretion, may amend Exhibit A from time to time, upon approval by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, if necessary, and written notice to the Local Government Entity.
- 3. **No Obligation by Local Government Entity.** The Local Government Entity is under no obligation to purchase any commodities offered by the County.
- 4. **No Obligation by County.** The County is under no obligation to provide a commodity requested by the Local Government Entity if the County is not in a position to honor the request.
- 5. **Total Cost Undetermined.** The total cost of the commodities to be provided under this agreement cannot be estimated in advance, but will be determined by the extent to which the Local Government Entity avails itself of the commodities available.
- 6. **Effective Dates.** This agreement shall be in effect from the date it is executed below until September 30, 2028.
- 7. **Early Termination.** Either party may terminate this agreement, with or without cause, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
- 8. County's Representative. The County's Administrator or its Director of Public Works and Engineering, or his/her respective designee, will act on behalf of the County with regard to the commodities available to the Local Government Entity.
- 9. Local Government Entity's Representative. The Local Government Entity's [indicate title of one or more authorized representatives]

 The Borough Administrator ______, or his/her respective designee, will act on behalf of the Local Government Entity with regard to a request for commodities from the County.

- 10. Payment of Invoices. The Local Government Entity will pay the County for commodities purchased under this agreement within thirty (30) days of the County's invoice for those commodities. If the Local Government Entity disputes a County invoice, the Local Government Entity will pay the undisputed portion and attempt to resolve the remaining portion in accordance with paragraph 11 below.
- 11. Disputes. This Contract shall be governed by and be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey. All disputes arising under this Contract shall be resolved exclusively in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Monmouth County.
- 12. **Indemnification.** Each party will indemnify the other party and hold the other party harmless for the negligent or intentional acts of the indemnifying party.
- Authority to Execute Agreement. The execution of this agreement has been duly authorized by the governing bodies of the County and the Local Government Entity.
- 14. Counterparts. This agreement may be fully executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one agreement binding upon all parties, notwithstanding that all parties have not signed the same counterpart. Such executions may be transmitted to the parties electronically or by facsimile, and such electronic or facsimile execution shall have the same force and effect as an original signature.
- 15. **Notices**. Any notices that are provided pursuant to this agreement shall be in writing (including facsimile and electronic transmissions) and mailed or transmitted or delivered as follows:

Operator maintains sufficient personal injury/property insurance for Venue sufficient to cover foreseeable claims.

WEST LONG BRANCH BOROUGH CLERK CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 2nd day of August 2023, at the Borough of West Long Branch, State of New Jersey, between the BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH, hereinafter referred to as the "Borough", a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, and CAROLINA SANTOS hereinafter referred to as "SANTOS".

The Borough does hereby engage and retain the services of SANTOS to serve as the Borough Clerk for the Borough of West Long Branch, which employment is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The Borough agrees to pay SANTOS an annual salary in 2023, retroactive to January 1, 2023, of \$80,000.
- 2. Any future annual salary of SANTOS, together with any other benefits such as paid days off, shall be as fixed by the Governing Body in its annual salary ordinance and/ or resolution.
- The salary referenced above shall be paid in semimonthly installments with all standard deductions (i.e., federal tax, state tax, social security, pension and life insurance) being deducted.
- 4. The initial appointment of SANTOS as BOROUGH CLERK shall begin on July 5, 2023, and continue until July 4, 2026 [3 years minus one day from date above per N.J.S.A. 40A:9-133a]. It is understood and agreed that the balance of the terms of this contract will continue in full force and effect upon any reappointment of SANTOS as Borough Clerk, unless such reappointment shall include a subsequently negotiated employment term not set forth herein.
- 5. SANTOS shall be entitled to thirteen (13) sick days per year. Any sick time not used will carry over to the following year. Upon retirement, SANTOS will not receive a lump sum payment for unused sick days.
- 6. SANTOS shall be entitled to the following vacation time:
 - a. Two weeks in each calendar year from the first through the fifth year of employment.
 - b. Three weeks per calendar year running from the sixth through tenth years of employment.
 - c. Four weeks per calendar year running from the eleventh through twentieth years of employment.
 - d. Five weeks per calendar year running from the twenty-first year of employment and running through Santos' retirement or termination of employment.

- e. SANTOS shall be permitted to carry over a maximum of two (2) weeks of unused vacation time into the following year, with the express proviso that all carried-over vacation time, together with the vacation time for the following year, must be used in that year. For example, if SANTOS has unused vacation time in year number three, she may carry a maximum of two weeks over into year number four, however, she must use in year number four.
- 7. SANTOS shall be entitled to one personal leave day for every four (4) months worked. This personal leave may not exceed three (3) days per year, nor may any personal days be carried over from any prior year. If not used, such personal days will be lost.
- 8. By her signature hereto, SANTOS expressly waives any right or entitlement to longevity benefits as a result of any prior governmental employment with an entity other than the Borough of West Long Branch.
- 9. SANTOS shall be on duty at Borough Hall at all times during business hours {Ord. 2-7.a}
- 10. SANTOS shall be entitled to all holidays off which are holidays for the administrative staff of the West Long Branch Borough.

11. DUTIES of BOROUGH CLERK:

- SANTOS shall perform the duties as set forth in Borough Ordinance 2-7 .1, any subsequent amendments to the same, and any other borough ordinances fixing the duties of the borough clerk; and as may be prescribed by state law, including, but not limited to, those duties prescribed in N.J.S.A. 40A:9-133e.
- 12. SANTOS shall attend all meetings of the Mayor and Council, and any meetings of any committee or subcommittee of the Borough Council when requested. She shall also attend any court or hearing procedures when the Mayor, Council, Administrator, or Attorney representing the Borough requests her presence.
- 13. SANTOS shall make herself available for emergencies (in person) or when otherwise needed (by phone) to the Mayor, Council, the Borough Administrator, any attorney representing the Borough, the Borough Engineer, the Police Chief or his designee, and all Department Heads.

14. SANTOS shall receive the same health insurance benefits as other borough employees, and she shall be charged in the same way as other borough employees for her portion of the premiums. SANTOS was hired prior to December 31, 2019, and therefore remains entitled to lifetime health benefits upon retirement of twenty-five years or more in service to the Borough.
