RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH MOSQUITO CONTROL DIVISION TO CONDUCT AERIAL MOSQUITO CONTROL OPERATIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:9-27 et seq. has elected through its Mosquito Control Division to perform all acts necessary for the elimination of mosquito breeding areas and/or to exterminate mosquitoes within the county; and

WHEREAS, the County has instituted an Integrated Pest Management Program consisting of surveillance, water management, biological control, and chemical control to exterminate the mosquito population within the county of Monmouth; and

WHEREAS, prior to conducting aerial dispensing operations over a designated "congested area," the County is required, pursuant to Federal Aviation Administration Regulation (FAR Part 137.51), to secure prior written approval from the governing body of the political subdivision over which the aircraft is to be operated; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Long Branch is designated as a "congested area" by the Federal Aviation Administration and the County has requested that this governing body consent to its proposed aerial dispensing operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch as follows:

- 1. The Borough Council hereby authorizes the County of Monmouth Mosquito Control Division or its agent to apply pesticides by aircraft for mosquito control in certain areas of the municipality designated by the County as being either larval mosquito habitat or areas harboring high populations of mosquitoes constituting either a nuisance, a health hazard, or both with the understanding that:
 - a. The County shall utilize pesticides, application equipment and aircraft that are approved for aerial applications by the applicable Federal (USEPA) and State (NJDEP) agencies; and
 - $\begin{tabular}{ll} {\bf b.} & {\bf Such operations will be performed in compliance with applicable Federal} \\ {\bf and State regulations; and } \end{tabular}$
 - c. The County will notify the police department of each municipality over which aerial pesticide operations are planned prior to commencement of such operations.

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO THE NEW JERSEY ATTORNEY GENERAL'S LAW ENFORCEMENT DIRECTIVE NUMBER 2018-6 REGARDING IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS, New Jersey Attorney General Gurbir S. Grewal issued law enforcement directive number 2018-6 on November 29, 2018, the effect of which will be to handicap law enforcement authorities from enforcing the law, a rather dramatic departure from the Attorney General's obligation to enforce the laws of this state and nation; and

WHEREAS, this directive would prohibit law enforcement officers from participating in ICE'S (Immigrations and Customs Enforcement) civil immigration enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General's directive would prohibit law enforcement officers from providing ICE with access to state or local law enforcement resources; and

WHEREAS, under the directive, law enforcement officers would be prohibited from holding a detained individual, who is arrested for a minor criminal offense, without certain prior convictions, past the time he or she would otherwise be released from custody simply because ICE has submitted an "immigration detainer" request; and

WHEREAS, nothing in the directive provides "sanctuary" to individuals who commit crimes in the state, it is felt that the effect of this directive would likely do so; and

WHEREAS, there are certainly some provisions of the directive which are reasonable and do not require comment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Long Branch that the governing body express its extreme displeasure and disappointment in having our Attorney General, the Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the State of New Jersey, issue a directive to all law enforcement entities and officers containing the provisions set forth above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to Attorney General Grewal, the Senator and Assembly Persons representing West Long Branch, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, and to the governing bodies of each municipality in Monmouth County.
