REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Mayor Tucci announced that the West Long Branch Library will be honoring Cindy Cioffi on her retirement, effective June 30th, at a reception on Friday, June 29th, at 1:00 PM, at the Library. She invited the Councilmembers to stop by the Library that morning to see Ms. Cioffi.

Mayor Tucci reported that the Monmouth County Sheriff has once again arranged to have the grass cut next week in the cemetery at the intersection of Locust Avenue and Wall Street.

Councilman Bray reported that the proposal submitted by MTB for repairs to the Borough Hall roof, in the amount of \$16,248, will be accepted. He thanked the Purchasing Agent, Dave Spaulding, for his assistance with this project.

Councilman Bray noted that the Borough Auditor was working on the 2017 audit and that an exit interview was scheduled for next Wednesday.

- The Emergency Medical Services Captain provided Monmouth University representatives with information they requested in connection with the request for a donation to purchase a power loader stretcher.

Councilwoman Mango advised that she had nothing to report on behalf of the Environmental and Shade Tree Commissions. She did announce that the Environmental Commission set the date for the fall shredding event for October 21st.

Councilwoman Mango thanked Kellie Campbell for leading the Green Team in preparing and submitting the Borough's application to Sustainable Jersey for bronze certification. She also recognized the Borough Administrator and Borough Clerk for their assistance on this project.

Councilwoman Mango stated that Heidi Bahr has been hired as the new Recreation Commission Secretary.

Councilwoman Mango reminded everyone that this year's Summer Recreation Program begins on June 25th.

Councilwoman Mango announced that the Recreation Commission has scheduled concerts on the following dates: July 4th, July 13th, July 27th, August 3rd, August 10th, and August 24th.

Councilwoman Mango reported that the Recreation Commission has been working on the design for the flags to be installed around Franklin Lake.

Councilwoman Mango announced that this year's Fall Festival has been scheduled for October 21st. She noted that the Recreation Commission will be coordinating with the West Long Branch Community Center to have a beer garden.

Councilwoman Mango reported that the bocce courts were almost finished, and she commended Councilmen Neyhart and Migliaccio for their work on them.

Councilman Neyhart stated that seventy children participated in the Annual Fishing Derby held on Saturday, June 9th. Registration took place from 9:00 AM to 9:30 AM. Then the children fished for two hours after which different awards were handed out to the participants. A total of eight-three fish were caught. Councilman Neyhart thanked the Council for supporting the event and recognized his family, the Recreation Commission, especially Debbie Ronan, Troop 145, former Police Chief Mihlon, Lieutenant Gomez, and Gerry Natale for their assistance.

Councilman Neyhart reported that work on the bocce courts began on May 30th. He recognized the following individuals/organizations for their assistance on

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this project: Eosso Brothers, Frank Mango, Dan Bonner, Tony Fontana, Gregg Malfa, Jamie Blake, Rus Olsen, Mark Engel, Joe DeSantis, Rich Egan, and the Public Works Department. He stated that the next step was to put in the stone dust, which was being donated by John Guire Company. That should be done within the next week or two. Councilwoman Mango thanked everyone that has been involved. Further, she asked if it was possible to install some sort of plaque recognizing the Recreation Commission. Councilman Neyhart stated that he would also like to raise funds to purchase benches and a scoreboard.

Councilman Penta stated that the Borough purchased and received two new pick-up trucks for the Public Works Department. He thanked the C.F.O., Purchasing Agent, and Finance Committee for making these purchases happen.

The Borough Administrator reported that the parts to repair the LED sign in front of Borough Hall have arrived and are waiting for the technician to install them. She pointed out that the vendor has not yet been paid for the sign in the meantime.

The Borough Administrator advised that the contractor was onsite at 95 Poplar Avenue today to install the orange fencing. According to the contractor, demolition was expected to begin tomorrow. Councilman Neyhart reminded the Borough Administrator to ensure that a piece of the building was saved for display in the museum.
