RESOLUTION DESIGNATING "AVENUE OF MEMORIES" AND ASSOCIATED ROADWAYS WITHIN THE FORMER FORT MONMOUTH MAIN CAMPUS LIMITS AS COUNTY ROUTE 537 IN THE BOROUGH OF EATONTOWN AND BROUGH OF OCEANPORT, AND RE-DESIGNATING A SEGMENT OF EXISTING COUNTY ROUTE 537 AS AN EXTENSION OF COUNTY ROUTE 547 IN THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, BOROUGH OF WEST LONG BRANCH AND THE CITY OF LONG BRANCH

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth has acquired by fee simple acquisition, including appurtenant easements, the "Avenue of Memories" and other certain roadways within the former Fort Monmouth Main Campus in the Borough of Eatontown and Borough of Oceanport to serve as an extension of County Route 537; and

**WHEREAS**, County Route 537 (Tinton Avenue) is currently segmented at its intersection with Broad Street/Main Street (State Route 35), opposite to Fort Monmouth's west gate in the Borough of Eatontown; and

**WHEREAS**, County Route 537 resumes as Eatontown Boulevard in the Borough of Oceanport at the intersection of Board Street/Monmouth Road (State Route 71), just east of County Route 547 (Wyckoff Road); and

**WHEREAS**, County Route 537 then continues as Broadway through the Borough of West Long Branch, terminating at the intersection of Myrtle Avenue in the City of Long Branch; and

**WHEREAS**, the fee simple acquisition of the Avenue of Memories and other certain roadways within the former Fort Monmouth Main Campus provides an opportunity to improve the designated route identifications of the County Route network; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Engineer and Planning Director have recommended to formally designate county route identification for the newly acquired roadways in the Borough of Eatontown and Borough of Oceanport, and to re-designate a segment of existing County Route 537 identification in the Borough of Oceanport, Borough of West Long Branch and the City of Long Branch.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth does hereby designate the newly acquired roadways, beginning at the intersection of State Route 35 at the Fort Monmouth's west gate in the Borough of Eatontown, "Avenue of Memories" and "Wilson Avenue" in the Borough of Eatontown and Borough of Oceanport; and "Sherrill Avenue", "Russel Avenue" (between Hildreth Avenue and Sanger Avenue), "Saltzman Avenue", and "Hildreth Avenue" in the Borough of Oceanport, terminating at the intersection of Oceanport Avenue (County Route 11) at the Fort Monmouth's east gate in the Borough of Oceanport within the former Fort Monmouth Main Campus as County Route 537.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that "Eatontown Boulevard" from the intersection of Broad Street/Monmouth Road (State Route 71) to Turtle Mill Brook in the Borough of Oceanport; "Broadway" from Turtle Mill Brook to the intersection of Oakwood Avenue in the Borough of West Long Branch; and "Broadway" from the intersection of Oakwood Avenue to the intersection of Myrtle Avenue in the City of Long Branch shall be re-designated from County Route 537 to County Route 547.

## PUBLIC HEARING:

Gerry Fawcett, Beechwood Avenue, addressed the following items:

• She asked for the status of the truck/van ordinance. The Borough Attorney informed her that he and members of the Police Department met with the Ordinance Review Committee about that ordinance last week. The focus of the discussion was on the types of vehicles, locations, and sizes. The Borough Attorney prepared a memo to the

to the Committee outlining what was discussed and will then prepare a draft ordinance for their review before it is submitted to the Council for consideration.

- She asked for the name of the current Prosecutor. She was told that Joseph Hughes was appointed to that position on January 1st.
- She asked about the status of the demolition of the 95 Poplar Avenue building. She was told that the permits had to be finalized.

Mary Lynch, Locust Avenue, questioned why her dog license and tag were mailed to her rather than issued at Borough Hall as was done in the past. The Borough Clerk replied that this year was handled differently because the person who normally issues them was out on maternity leave.

Vincent Lepore, 33 Ocean Terrace, Long Branch, confirmed that notices were sent out to local government agencies by the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Highway Administration advising that the painting of the blue line in support of law enforcement was unsafe because blue lines are meant for marking handicap parking spaces. Councilman Neyhart stated his refusal to remove the blue line painted along Locust Avenue. Mayor Tucci noted that she received numerous phone calls commending the Borough for painting the line.

Gerry Fawcett, Beechwood Avenue, asked if Monmouth University is going to donate towards this year's fireworks display.

There being no one else wishing to speak, on motion made by Councilman Neyhart, seconded by Councilwoman Juliano, and carried unanimously, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
