- His office founded the #EveryKidCounts campaign to call on the state to meet its commitments to struggling school districts and was successful in getting a 21.8% increase in extraordinary special education aid.
- He noted there were challenges because some municipalities have banned plastic bags while others have not. Instead, he would like to pass a statewide ban to provide equality.
- He mentioned he was pushing a school district regionalization plan bill, which would affect West Long Branch.

At this point, Senator Gopal asked the Mayor and Council if they had any questions or comments.

Mayor Tucci pointed out that the Borough has already entered several shared service agreements that were working well.

Councilman Penta questioned whether the Senator was getting pushback from the NJEA on the school regionalization plan.

Councilman Neyhart requested the Senator's assistance with lights that the municipality was paying for but were out. Senator Gopal offered to speak with him after the meeting to obtain some of the locations he was referencing so they could be addressed.

Senator Gopal congratulated Councilman Migliaccio on his appointment as County Fire Marshal.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Councilman Bray read the following report:

- On 8/21/19, the Finance Committee held the audit exit interview with Robert Oliwa, Mike Martin, and Stephanie Dollinger. Mr. Oliwa, our municipal accountant, was very pleased with the results of the audit as well as the financial condition of the Borough. The audit was submitted before the state deadline and the copy of the audit was distributed by Ms. Cole to the Mayor and Council. We will have the formal resolution accepting the audit report at the September 18th Council meeting.
- On a separate note, the CFO has finalized the process of setting up the Borough bank accounts with Investor's Bank and has started depositing funds into those accounts. As we discussed previously, these accounts provide the Borough with better rates. The other accounts will remain open until the appropriate time period to make sure any issued checks are cleared or cancelled.
- The Committee reviewed the Applicant Instructions written by Julie Nastasi and we also had Jim Miller review them as well. This was to improve our planning and zoning board application process. We now have the instructions up on the website and we will monitor to see if we need to enhance the instructions.

Councilwoman Mango reported that the summer concerts were done for this year and that there was a good turnout.

Councilwoman Mango mentioned that the Summer Recreation Director and Assistant Director attended the last meeting of the Recreation Commission and gave a recap. The Program was a success even though it had a rough start. It was held at Frank Antonides School, and she noted that the Custodian and IT Personnel were very helpful. Finally, she confirmed that there were only two trips planned because of the cost of the bus.

Councilwoman Mango announced the following upcoming events:

Mayor Tucci pointed out that the Recreation Commission decided to offer fewer concerts this year so they could book bigger acts. Also, she indicated that there was only one problem during the Summer Recreation Program, but that was attributed to this being a transition year.
